AWARD INFORMATION

Award Categories:

This yearly award is offered in the following two categories and does include barns (Consideration will be given for both exterior and interior work):

- 1. Residential buildings
- 2. Commercial buildings

Review Criteria:

Project review will include, but not be limited necessarily to the following standards:

- I. **Restoration** (Restoration is the act of returning a building and/or landscape to its former condition.)
 - > Bringing back architectural features through reproductions of originals determined by historical research
 - > Replacing inappropriate modern window styles with windows that match the original style of the building
 - Researching paint colors and repainting to replicate the period style
 - Researching and replacing landscaping elements, such as fences, walkways, lighting and vegetation
 - > Reuse of original materials
- II. **Preservation** (Preservation is the act of maintaining and keeping up a building and/or landscape in its original condition, as much as possible while still adapting it to modern living.)

- ➤ Retaining and maintaining all original windows (these can be made energy efficient; aluminum exterior storm windows can be replaced with interior storms, etc)
- > Retaining and maintaining all original character defining architectural features
- > Retaining and maintaining barns and outbuildings
- Retaining and maintaining original landscaping features wherever possible; replacing with same varieties and species of plants wherever possible. This also pertains to fences, lighting, walkway locations and materials, etc.

Other Information:

- > The award consists of recognition and a plaque that can be displayed on the front of the building.
- > The plaque would give the name of any historic owner or event and year the house was built.
- > The plaque would be awarded by the Keene Heritage Commission to the applicant at formal presentation. Newspaper and web announcements would follow.
- At the discretion of the Heritage Commission, one or two awards in each category of residential and commercial may be given yearly.
- > This program is open to all city property owners who wish to commemorate the origins, events, or significance of a building on their property.
