Time Limitations for Certain Activities

**BACKGROUND:**

Councilor Filiault is asking that the City Council consider eliminating the hours of operation which is established by the City Code for hawking or peddling with the City.

SUBJECT: Hours of Operation – Mobile Vendors  
FROM: Councilor Randy Filiault

As of late, I have been receiving concern from licensed hawkers and peddlers that there is confusion and potentially inconsistent hours of operation between hawkers and peddlers in the City. The City Code establishes the hours of operation to be no earlier than 9 a.m. or any later than 9 p.m. Daylight Savings Time or 7:00 pm Eastern Standard Time. The City Code also allows a hawker or peddler to request an extension of the time period by approaching the City Council.

I am suggesting that the City not regulate the hours of operation and allow these establishments the freedom to set their own hours.

**Sec. 46-121. - Time limitations for certain activities.**

- (a) With respect to any license issued or any activity authorized by the filing of a certificate of registration under division 2, of article IV, of this chapter pertaining to charitable and nonprofit solicitation or operations conducted pursuant to the granting of such license or the issuance of such certificate of registration, the activity shall not commence prior to 8:00 a.m. nor continue after 9:00 p.m. during Daylight Saving Time or 7:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time.
- (b) With respect to any license issued under division 2, of article V, of this chapter pertaining to commercial solicitation permits, or division 2, of article IX, of this chapter pertaining to itinerant vendors, activities shall not commence prior to 9:00 a.m. nor continue after 9:00 p.m. during Daylight Saving Time or 7:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time.
- (c) ***With respect to any license issued under division 2, of article VIII, of this chapter pertaining to hawkers and peddlers, activities shall not commence prior to 9:00 a.m. nor continue after 9:00 p.m. during Daylight Saving Time or 7:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time unless otherwise authorized by city council in accordance with subsection (d) below.***
- (d) ***Any hawker or peddler requesting permission to commence activities prior to 9:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m. during Daylight Saving Time or 7:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time shall do so in writing to the city council. City council may grant said permission with reasonable conditions and terms deemed necessary for public convenience and safety.***
