## **Approval of Minutes**

Ms. Silver made a motion to approve minutes of the October 17, 2018, Ms. Snow seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

## **Distribution of MS9's**

Mrs. Gray distributed the MS9's for the three portfolios; Mrs. Gray advised that that the capital reserves and the library renovation trust fund are accurate. The common trust funds are still pending. Mrs. Gray indicated that the report she distributed is the new version, and to the best of her knowledge there has been no resolution with the state regarding the calculation/reporting of market values.

#### #503 CLEMENT WOODWARD

Mrs. Gray presented a disbursement totaling \$2,363.14 for payments made to Rite Aid in November. These expenses were approved, as required, by the Woodward committee on September 13, 2018. Supporting documentation was provided for Trustee review.

Mr. Forrest made a motion to approve as presented, Ms. Silver seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

## **Ashuelot River Park**

Mr. Bohannon was present to request an increase in expenditures for tree removal of \$3,300.00 in the 2018 ARP budget. In the creation of the 2017 budget the tree trimming line was reduced by \$1,075.00 to keep the line item under \$3,000.00, upon providing the proposal back to Bartlett Tree they intended to push the project to 2018. Bartlett Tree subsequently created a work order, which was never presented to the Advisory Board in the 2018 budget development, and then they proceeded with the work. Mr. Bohannon stated the work was needed and completed by Bartlett Tree this past August. Mr. Bohannon stated that this was clearly an honest oversight on the part of Bartlett Tree.

Mr. Bohannon stated that he is seeking a reimbursement to City - Parks & Recreation division in the amount of \$1,075.00.

Ms. Snow made a motion to approve the expense as presented, Mr. Forrest seconded. Motion carried 3-0, Ms. Silver recused.

## Good Afternoon,

As follow-up to our earlier conversation I wanted to confirm, in writing, a conversation that I had with Terry Knowles earlier today regarding the ability to report the Common Funds by market value on the new Trustees of the Trust Funds on-line reporting system (NHTFF). The NHTFF has been updated to accommodate communities who have historically reported by market value – not cost – on the annual MS9's. An unrealized gain/loss field is now available on the NHTFF to allow for the calculation and reporting by market value.

I specifically confirmed with Terry that the City of Keene does not need to change the past market value reporting methodology. We discussed that the City's MS9's and 10's are prepared by Cambridge Trust and she said to feel free to give her a call if you had any questions. I am cc'ing her on this email.

Therefore, I would request that you provide the City with revised monthly MS9's utilizing the past methodology calculations (market value) for July 2018 through December 2018 and then continue going forward. We realize that this is creating additional work and we appreciate your customer service.

In addition, as we discussed the City filed paper MS9's and 10's for 2018 so Cambridge will not be uploading a 2018 file to the NHTFF for the City of Keene. After discussion with the State they said that is OK and probably a very good idea to input the 2018 data as a starting point for 2019, so I will be manually inputting the data from 2018 over the next several weeks in order to setup up the funds and have an ending balance that will roll forward to 2019. I will contact you when I have the input complete for your review — before I submit it. I think that once I have everything input it will make it easier for you to see where I went wrong (!!) and check to see that I have things in the proper categories. Hopefully this will make things a little easier for the 2019 file upload.

Thanks again for your assistance through this process. Greatly appreciated.

## Resolved by the City Council of the City of Keene, as follows:

Whereas the City of Keene transportation infrastructure is essential to the economic

development and vibrancy of City promoting opportunities for prosperity of our

community,

Whereas the roads, bridges, sidewalks, bicycle and pedestrian facilities envisioned by the

Comprehensive Master Plan require additional resources, and

Whereas the City's adopted fiscal policies state that the City will strive to diversify its

revenues,

Now therefore be it resolved that the City of Keene establishes a municipal transportation improvement fund as authorized by RSA 261:153, VI to allow the City to fund, wholly or in part, improvements in the transportation system including roads, bridges, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, parking, and intermodal facilities, except for parking, in accordance with RSA 261:153, VI to be funded by a surcharge of \$5 on motor vehicle registrations.

Upon the prior approval of the City Council for any expenditure, the funds may be used for engineering, right of way acquisition, and construction costs of transportation facilities. It may also be used as a source for matching funds for state or federal funds allocated for transportation improvements.

The Trustees of Trust Funds for the City of Keene shall make payment to the City of Keene, on a reimbursement basis, based on reports provided by the City Manager or his/her designee.

This resolution and the authority granted by it shall remain in effect until rescinded.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CEMETERY TRUSTEES, TRUST FUNDS, CAPITAL RESERVES AND FEES

## Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Keene, as follows:

That the City Ordinances of the City of Keene, New Hampshire, as amended, be and hereby are further amended by deleting in Chapter 3, entitled "Boards", section 7, entitled "Trustees of Trust Funds", the following:

Title, subsection A, entitled "Membership", and subsection B, entitled "Terms", and inserting in place thereof the following new title, subsection A and subsection B, to read as follows:

#### "SECTION 7. TRUSTEES OF TRUST FUNDS AND CEMETERY TRUSTEES

- A. MEMBERSHIP. The Trustees of Trust Funds and Cemetery Trustees shall be a City Board consisting of three members.
- At the second regular City Council meeting in January of each year, the Mayor shall nominate one or more qualified persons to membership on the Board, one of whom shall be elected by majority vote of a quorum of the City Council at its next regular meeting after the nominations. In the event that no nominee is elected as set forth above, the Mayor shall nominate additional qualified persons to membership on the Board at each succeeding regular City Council meeting until one is elected as aforesaid.

and further amending said section 7 by adding thereto a new subsection 18, to read as follows:

- "18. Be the Cemetery Trustees of the City of Keene and shall perform all duties incumbent upon that office by law."
- That the City Ordinances of the City of Keene, New Hampshire, as amended, be and hereby are further amended by striking out in Chapter 7, entitled "ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENTS", section 8, entitled "Parks, Recreation and Cemetery Department", subsection 2, entitled "Cemeteries", subsection C. thereof, entitled "Price of Lots", as inserted by Ordinance 0-83-50, and inserting in place of said subsection C. the following new subsection C. to read as follows:
  - PRICE OF LOTS AND CEMETERY FUNDS. All funds raised and appropriated by the City for the care and maintenance of cemeteries shall be held by and expended under the direction of the Cemetery Trustees after receiving the recommendations of the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cemeteries, and soliciting any advice from him that the Cemetery Trustees may desire. be their duty to supervise all public cemeteries to the end that said funds may be so expended as best to serve the purposes for which they are raised and appropriated.

Ordinance 0-85-11A - Relating to Cemetery Trustees, Trust Funds, Capital Reserves and Fees
Page Two

There are hereby created two City trust funds to be funded as hereinafter described to be held by the Cemetery Trustees with their principal and the income thereon expended under the direction of the Cemetery Trustees, with the recommendations and advice of the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cemeteries, as best to serve their purposes as herein described.

CEMETERY TRUST FUND A - PERPETUAL CARE OF CEMETERIES. percent (50%) of the funds derived from the sale of the lots in those sections of the public cemeteries designated for perpetual care shall be retained separately from other funds in an account designated Cemetery Fund A. Said percentage paid shall be considered as full payment by the lot purchaser for care of the lot by the City in perpetuity. The Finance Department shall annually make a report of the condition of Cemetery Fund A to the City Council and to the Cemetery Trustees and shall request that the Council, by resolution, appropriate the balance of Cemetery Fund A to Cemetery Trust Fund A - Perpetual Care of Cemeteries, or make such other disposition as the Cemetery Trustees may request. The income of said Cemetery Trust Fund A - Perpetual Care of Cemeteries, may be expended by the Cemetery Trustees for the care and maintenance of cemeteries on an annual or such other basis as the Cemetery Trustees shall deem appropriate. Cemetery Trustees shall call upon the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cemeteries for his recommendations from time to time and may solicit his advice as they may find helpful in carrying out their duties hereunder.

CEMETERY TRUST FUND B - CEMETERY CAPITAL RESERVE. All sums received from the sale of lots except that part credited into Cemetery Fund A shall be credited into Fund B. The Finance Department shall annually make a report of the condition of Cemetery Fund B to the City Council and the Cemetery Trustees and shall request that the Council, by resolution, appropriate the balance of Fund B to Trust Fund B - Cemetery Capital Reserve, make such other disposition as the Cemetery Trustees may request. The purpose of Trust Fund B shall be as a capital reserve fund to be utilized by the Cemetery Trustees from time to time for capital improvements to and enlargements of the public cemeteries of the City. The Cemetery Trustees may expend the principal and income in Trust Fund B - Cemetery Capital Reserve, from time to time in order to effect the purposes for which the fund was established. The Cemetery Trustees shall call upon the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cemeteries for his recommendations from time to time and may solicit his advice as they may find helpful in carrying out their duties hereunder.

## Exhibit A

## ASHUELOT RIVER PARK MEMORIAL FUND

- I. Creation and Administration. There is hereby created a City trust fund to be held and administered by the Trustees of Trust Funds and the Cemetery Trustees (the "Trustees") to be known as the Ashuelot River Park Memorial Fund (the "Fund"). The Trustees shall accept all unconditional contributions, bequests, and other gifts payable on demand in United States currency or marketable securities to the Fund. All such gifts of securities shall be sold upon receipt and the proceeds added to the Fund. All funds so received shall be used as set forth herein by the Trustees, or as nearly so as they can determine to be practicable in order to carry out the intent of this Fund as described herein.
- II. Application Principal. The principal of the Fund, and any interest thereon, shall be applied exclusively toward the purchase of the property at 273 West Street, Keene, New Hampshire (the "Property") by the City of Keene and any expenses related thereto until the earlier of (A) July 1, 1995 or (B) the date the purchase is consumated. The Trustees shall invest all funds received by the Fund as they are authorized to do so by law until and unless the funds are requested by the City of Keene for the purchase of 273 West Street, Keene, New Hampshire or for expenses related thereto.
- III. Excess Principal. In the event that there is principal in the Fund in excess of the amount needed for the purchase of the Property or in the event that the Property is not purchased by July 1, 1996, then the Trustees may expend such principal, and any interest thereon, for the future development and improvement of the Ashuelot River Park as the City of Keene may request from time to time, including, but not limited to, the purchase of the Property, if such purchase has not been completed on or before July 1, 1996.
- IV. <u>Cessation of Fund</u>. This Fund shall cease to exist at any time after July 1, 1996, that the principal amount thereof equals zero.

The Advisory Board prepares a budget, based on no more than 90% of the income earned in the prior year, for use for yearly maintenance. There is a contract with JM to do the maintenance work and in addition \$500 for Miscellaneous. The Advisory Board recommends the budget to be approved by the Trustees. This is usually done in January or February before the "season". During the season the work can be done according to the budget and will be reimbursed by the Trust.

Expenses for work to be done outside the budget must be presented by the Board to the Trustees for approval before any work is done. Backup for the disbursement should be an invoice and Advisory board minutes with a reimbursement request.

## Hi Tom -

Andy explained to me that the current owner of 0 Ashuelot Street - JRR Properties, LLC - wants to develop the property (not sure what that means - it is now a parking lot) and then GIVE it to the City to be added to the Ashuelot River Park for park uses. Tom Hanna is the Registered Agent for JRR Properties, LLC.

In looking through the files in this office and also the City Clerk's files I can provide you the following outline relative to the transfer of property in 1996, that established the West Street entrance to the park.

- In the fall of 1995, the City was approached by The Friends of the Ashuelot River Park to purchase the vacant lot located adjacent to the park at 273 West Street. At that time, The Foundation for the Preservation of Historic Keene held a transferrable option to purchase the lot. Don Davis, a Friends member (deceased), explained at the FOP meeting of September 28, 1995, that the Friends didn't have enough time to set up a 501(c)(3) organization to accept tax deductible donations before the option expired. In addition, the Friends had understood that the property had already been subdivided but discovered it had not. Because of the time sensitivity it was requested that the option be transferred to the City.
- Gift of Option letter to Mayor and Council submitted by the Foundation dated October 17, 1995
- R-95-33 Relating to Acceptance of Gift of Option to Purchase Passed October 19, 1995
- R-95-34 Relating to Establishment of Ashuelot River Park Memorial Fund Passed October 19, 1995
- R-95-35 Relating to Exercise of Option to Purchase 273 West Street Passed October 19, 1995 (with conditions see below)
  - → Sufficient funds in the Ashuelot River Park Memorial Fund to purchase property

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CHAPTER 0800.0, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS
AND TRUSTS - SPECIFIC, - ASHUELOT RIVER PARK ADVISORY
BOARD

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Keene, as follows:

That the Ordinances of the City of Keene, New Hampshire, as amended, are hereby further amended by making the following additions to Chapter 0800.0, Boards, Commissions and Trusts - Specific:

Amendment #1: In Section 0801.0, "Boards and Commissions", add the following text to the alphabetical listing of existing boards and commissions: Ashuelot River Park Advisory Board.

Amendment #2: Add a new Section 0803.0, "Ashuelot River Park Advisory Board", as follows and renumber the following sections as necessary.

# 0803.0 ASHUELOT RIVER PARK ADVISORY BOARD

0803.1 Purpose. The Ashuelot River Park Advisory Board is created to promote, enhance, and maintain the Ashuelot River Park for its present and future use, enjoyment, and educational benefit for all residents of the City of Keene.

O803.2 Membership. The Ashuelot River Park Advisory Board shall consist of five (5) regular voting members who shall have demonstrated interest in the Park. One (1) member shall represent the educational community; one (1) member shall represent the Arboretum Committee; one (1) member shall represent the Friends of Ashuelot River Park; one (1) member shall be a City Councilor; and one (1) member shall represent the community at large. The Mayor shall be an ex officio member of the Board.

0803.3 Terms. Initially one (1) member shall have a one (1) year term, one (1) member shall have a two (2) year term, one (1) member shall have a three (3) year term, one (1) member shall have a four (4) year term, and one

(1) member shall have a five (5) year term. After these initial terms, all members shall have five (5) year terms.

0803.4 Relation to Department. The Parks, Recreation, and Cemetery Director shall report to the Board on the activity of his/her office and receive advice from the Board on matters relating to the Ashuelot River Park.

0803.5 Functions and Guidelines. The following functions and guidelines are hereby established for the conduct of the Board. The Board shall:

Promote the development of the Ashuelot River Park in accordance with the adopted vision statement and park plan.

Promote communciation and exchange of ideas and concerns between park users, City staff, and City Council.

Make reports and recommendations to the Public Works, Recreation, and Airport Committee of the City Council and to the City staff with respect to management of the Park.

Act as a publicity agent for the Park by bringing the benefits of the Park to the attention of the public.

Serve as an advocate for the interest of the Park.

Serve as the catalyst for bringing private resources to the Park, receive gifts of money and property, both real and personal, in the name of the City of Keene subject to the specific approval of the City Council, and transfer all money and property donated or bequeathed for the Park to the custody of the Trustees of Trust Funds.

Recommend the expenditure of trust frunds.

Assist in developing and stating objectives and goals for Park improvement.

Pursue the means of achieving the determined goals for improvement.

Perform such other related functions as required by the City Council or as requested by the City Manager.
