RE: Request for Library Trust Funds held by the City

For Meeting: January 20, 2021

The Keene Public Library, the Historical Society of Cheshire County and the New Hampshire State Library have agreed to work together toward the digitization of Keene's historic newspaper, currently known as the Keene Sentinel. This project will allow free, full, searchable access to any person wishing to do historical and genealogical research on this region of New Hampshire. This initial portion of the project will allow for the Sentinel to be digitized through at least 1923, at the cost of \$15,000. The Library will provide \$6,000 toward the total cost. The Historical Society is doing additional separate fundraising to digitize the collection from 1923 to 1945.

Karen Gray has provided me with the most recent available values of appropriate Trust funds held for the Library. The Trust documents and my request were reviewed and approved by City Attorney Thomas Mullins.

Upon your approval for the spending of \$5,025 in Trust funds, the New Hampshire State Library will invoice Keene Public Library for \$6,000. The balance of the Library's funding, \$975, will be drawn from the Library's Collection budget line (01100-62715). The funds will be deposited in escrow account of the 501c3 entity, The Park Street Foundation, until payment is required by the digitizer, Advantage Preservation of Ohio.

The New Hampshire State Library will host the digitized Sentinel newspapers, as they do for other New Hampshire newspapers.

#### **AGREEMENT**

AGREEMENT as of the last signature date below, by and among the Keene Public Library, with a mailing address of 60 Winter Street, Keene, New Hampshire, 03431 ("Keene Library"), the Historical Society of Cheshire County, with a mailing address of P.O. Box 803, Keene, New Hampshire, 03431 ('Historical Society"), and the New Hampshire State Library, with a mailing address of 20 park Street, Concord, New Hampshire, 03301 ('State Library") (collectively "Parties"):

WHEREAS, the Parties have jointly agreed to perform certain tasks, and to contribute funds or other in kind administrative support, for the purpose of digitizing and making available to the public through the world wide web or otherwise, certain publications of the Keene Sentinel newspaper, also f/k/a Keene Evening Sentinel ("Project"), owned by the Keene Publishing Corporation ("Keene Publishing"); and

WHEREAS, Keene Publishing has provided written authorization to the Parties to proceed with the Project which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein including newspaper digitization through the year 1923; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to memorialize their mutual understanding of the rights and obligations of the Parties in completing the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the rights and obligations as stated below, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The State Library will obtain the master newspapers for digitization up to and through the year 1923, and to pay for any shipping costs associated therewith; will provide administrative support and any associated costs for such support to the Project; and will make a cash contribution to the Project in the amount of 10% of the Project cost, up a maximum of \$1,500.00. Upon completion, the Project will be available to the general public through the world wide web without charge, and posted to the internet and maintained in a manner as determined by the State Library upon consultation with the Keene Library and the Historical Society.
- 2. The Keene Library will provide funding for the Project paid directly to the State Library from appropriate library resources as determined by the library in the total amount of \$6,000.00.
- 3. The Historical Society will provide funding for the Project directly to the State Library from appropriate resources as determined by the Historical Society in the total minimum amount of \$7,500.00.

- 4. The timing for, and the manner of submitting the contribution payments to the State Library will be determined by the State Library upon prior consultation with the Keene Library and the Historical Society.
- 5. The Parties may request from one another an accounting of contributions made to the Project, and any costs or expenses related to the Project.
- 6. This Agreement states the intentions and the understandings of the Parties, and may not be amended except in writing agreed to by the Parties.
- 7. Upon completion, the Project shall be owned by the State Library but subject to the Project being available to the public as required by this Agreement.

#### Recommendation:

Move that the Trustees of Trust Funds authorize the expenditure of the Rachel Marshall Trust Fund for the purpose of fulfilling the Ashuelot River Park Master Plan.

#### Background:

In 2020, the Conway School of Landscape Design completed a Climate Resilient Master Plan for the Ashuelot River Park Arboretum and Rachel Marshall Outdoor Learning Lab. Included in the plan were several features that will need funding. The Trust was originally used for outdoor education provided by Antioch University for local school aged children. The program ended in 2006, since then the trust has been used for various projects in Robin Hood Park and now Patricia T. Russell Park.

A trust balance of roughly \$27,000.00 currently remains and the Trust was originally to expire back in 2015. At the time, the funds were designated for improvements in Patricia T Russell Park, however, the project has been funded through the Capital Improvement Program and the potential for a sizable grant from the Land Water and Conservation Fund. In addition, the Ashuelot River Park Master plan had not been conceived or discussed until 2018 when the need became apparent to accomplish future goals. The Conway designs provided that direction and the trusts funds could help establish initial work outlined by the Ashuelot River Park Advisory Board prioritization list.

Therefore, a request to expend the trust will move the project forward towards a larger initiative.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CEMETERY TRUSTEES, TRUST FUNDS, CAPITAL RESERVES AND FEES

# Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Keene, as follows:

I. That the City Ordinances of the City of Keene, New Hampshire, as amended, be and hereby are further amended by deleting in Chapter 3, entitled "Boards", section 7, entitled "Trustees of Trust Funds", the following:

Title, subsection A, entitled "Membership", and subsection B, entitled "Terms", and inserting in place thereof the following new title, subsection A and subsection B, to read as follows:

#### "SECTION 7. TRUSTEES OF TRUST FUNDS AND CEMETERY TRUSTEES

- A. MEMBERSHIP. The Trustees of Trust Funds and Cemetery Trustees shall be a City Board consisting of three members.
- B. At the second regular City Council meeting in January of each year, the Mayor shall nominate one or more qualified persons to membership on the Board, one of whom shall be elected by majority vote of a quorum of the City Council at its next regular meeting after the nominations. In the event that no nominee is elected as set forth above, the Mayor shall nominate additional qualified persons to membership on the Board at each succeeding regular City Council meeting until one is elected as aforesaid.

and further amending said section 7 by adding thereto a new subsection 18, to read as follows:

- "18. Be the Cemetery Trustees of the City of Keene and shall perform all duties incumbent upon that office by law."
- II. That the City Ordinances of the City of Keene, New Hampshire, as amended, be and hereby are further amended by striking out in Chapter 7, entitled "ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENTS", section 8, entitled "Parks, Recreation and Cemetery Department", subsection 2, entitled "Cemeteries", subsection C. thereof, entitled "Price of Lots", as inserted by Ordinance 0-83-50, and inserting in place of said subsection C. the following new subsection C. to read as follows:
  - C. PRICE OF LOTS AND CEMETERY FUNDS. All funds raised and appropriated by the City for the care and maintenance of cemeteries shall be held by and expended under the direction of the Cemetery Trustees after receiving the recommendations of the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cemeteries, and soliciting any advice from him that the Cemetery Trustees may desire. It shall be their duty to supervise all public cemeteries to the end that said funds may be so expended as best to serve the purposes for which they are raised and appropriated.

Ordinance 0-85-11A - Relating to Cemetery Trustees, Trust Funds, Capital Reserves and Fees
Page Two

There are hereby created two City trust funds to be funded as hereinafter described to be held by the Cemetery Trustees with their principal and the income thereon expended under the direction of the Cemetery Trustees, with the recommendations and advice of the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cemeteries, as best to serve their purposes as herein described.

CEMETERY TRUST FUND A - PERPETUAL CARE OF CEMETERIES. percent (50%) of the funds derived from the sale of the lots in those sections of the public cemeteries designated for perpetual care shall be retained separately from other funds in an account designated Cemetery Fund A. Said percentage paid shall be considered as full payment by the lot purchaser for care of the lot by the City in perpetuity. The Finance Department shall annually make a report of the condition of Cemetery Fund A to the City Council and to the Cemetery Trustees and shall request that the Council, by resolution, appropriate the balance of Cemetery Fund A to Cemetery Trust Fund A - Perpetual Care of Cemeteries, or make such other disposition as the Cemetery Trustees may request. The Income of said Cemetery Trust Fund A - Perpetual Care of Cemeteries, may be expended by the Cemetery Trustees for the care and maintenance of cemeteries on an vannual or such other basis as the Cemetery Trustees shalk deem appropriate. Cemetery Trustees shall call upon the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cemeteries for his recommendations from time to time and may solicit his advice as they may find helpful in carrying out their duties hereunder.

CEMETERY TRUST FUND B - CEMETERY CAPITAL RESERVE. All sums received from the sale of lots except that part credited into... Cemetery Fund A shall be credited into Fund B. The Finance Department shall annually make a report of the condition of Cemetery Fund B to the City Council and the Cemetery Trustees and shall request that the Council, by resolution, appropriate the balance of Fund B to Trust Fund B - Cemetery Capital Reserve, or make such other disposition as the Cemetery Trustees may request. The purpose of Trust Fund B shall be as a capital reserve fund to be utilized by the Cemetery Trustees from time to time for capital improvements to and enlargements of the public cemeteries of the City. The Cemetery Trustees may expend the principal and income in Trust Fund B - Cemetery Capital Reserve, from time to time in order to effect the purposes for which the fund was The Cemetery Trustees shall call upon the Director established. of Parks, Recreation and Cemeteries for his recommendations from time to time and may solicit his advice as they may find helpful in carrying out their duties hereunder.

the roads, bridges, sidewalks, bicycle and pedestrian facilities envisioned by the Comprehensive Master Plan require additional resources, and

Whereas

the City's adopted fiscal policies state that the City will strive to diversify its revenues,

Now therefore be it resolved that the City of Keene establishes a municipal transportation improvement fund as authorized by RSA 261:153, VI to allow the City to fund, wholly or in part, improvements in the transportation system including roads, bridges, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, parking, and intermodal facilities, except for parking, in accordance with RSA 261:153, VI to be funded by a surcharge of \$5 on motor vehicle registrations.

Upon the prior approval of the City Council for any expenditure, the funds may be used for engineering, right of way acquisition, and construction costs of transportation facilities. It may also be used as a source for matching funds for state or federal funds allocated for transportation improvements.

The Trustees of Trust Funds for the City of Keene shall make payment to the City of Keene, on a reimbursement basis, based on reports provided by the City Manager or his/her designee.

This resolution and the authority granted by it shall remain in effect until rescinded.
