SUBJECT: Use of Old Gilsum Road - Public Works Director/Emergency Management Director

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Planning, License and Development Committee recommends Mr. Kevin Leary, 27 Meetinghouse Road, Keene, to be authorized to use a motorized vehicle on the Old Gilsum Road from the intersection with Timberlane Drive to parcel #218-009-00-00 owned by the Fontaine Albert R. Revocable Trust upon demonstration that he has documented permission to access the parcel.

BACKGROUND:

When the City Council discontinued the Old Gilsum Road to a Class VI highway the following restrictions was placed on the road.

Sec. 94-238. - Closed Streets.

Old Gilsum Road, a class VI highway, closed subject to gates and bars, pursuant to the provisions of RSA 47:17(VIII) is closed to vehicular traffic unless otherwise permitted by the city council. Notwithstanding the fact that Old Gilsum Road is closed to vehicular traffic, owners of property abutting on Old Gilsum Road shall not be prohibited from using the right-of-way of such Old Gilsum Road for purposes of gaining access to their respective properties at their own risk.

Since Mr. Leary is not the owner of the Fontaine Albert R. Revocable Trust parcel he is required to seek permission from the City Council for use of the Old Gilsum Road by a motorized vehicle. The City Council has given previous permission to the Keene Sno-riders to use the upper portion of the Old Gilsum Road with snow machines and trail grooming equipment.

If the City Council wishes to grant permission it would be on the condition that the use by motorized vehicle is only for access to the Fontaine Albert R. Revocable Trust property.

SUBJECT: Introducing a New Citizen Reporting System - City Engineer

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Municipal Services, Facilities and Infrastructure Committee recommend that the City Council accept the report as informational.

BACKGROUND:

Until recently, residents and visitors of Keene have been able to report non-emergency problems and maintenance needs using a cellular phone application (App) called "YourGov". This app is no longer supported, so the City is launching a replacement reporting system.

The New system is called "SeeClickFix". This App is available for both the Apple and Android operating systems. You can also submit requests on your computer directly from the City's website (https://ci.keene.nh.us/) or at https://seeclickfix.com/keene.

Staff from Public Works will give the Committee a brief demonstration of the new system and answer any questions that may arise.
