

Face Coverings Required

EMPLOYEES, WHILE PERFORMING THEIR DUTIES, ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A FACE COVERING COMPLETELY COVERING THEIR MOUTH AND NOSE AT ALL TIMES WHEN INTERACTING WITH THE PUBLIC UNLESS A BARRIER APPROVED BY THE CITY HEALTH OFFICIAL PROVIDES SUFFICIENT SEPARATION.

MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ENTERING ANY BUSINESS FOR ANY PURPOSE INCLUDING ANY OUTDOOR AREA WHERE BUSINESS IS CONDUCTED ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A FACE COVERING COMPLETELY COVERING THEIR NOSE AND MOUTH WHILE CONDUCTING THEIR BUSINESS; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A FACE COVERING WHILE ACTUALLY SEATED AT A RESTAURANT TABLE.

RESIDENTS, VISITORS AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ENTERING OR PRESENT WITHIN A RESIDENTIAL APARTMENT COMPLEX CONTAINING THREE OR MORE RESIDENTIAL UNITS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A FACE COVERING OVER THEIR NOSE AND MOUTH WHILE IN THE INTERIOR COMMON AREAS UNLESS SOCIAL DISTANCING OF SIX FEET CAN BE MAINTAINED. THIS REQUIREMENT SHALL ALSO APPLY TO ANY BUSINESS HAVING SUCH COMMON AREAS, NOTWITHSTANDING THE NUMER OF BUSINESS UNITS WITHIN THE BUSINESS COMPLEX.
