A RESOLUTION RELATING TO STANDARDIZE TELEPHONES FOR FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS.....


Resolved by the City Council of the City of Keene, as follows:


WHEREAS: The City of Keene provides 24 hour, seven day per week, emergency services; and

WHEREAS: The key function of effective response is proper, timely, and reliable information, the emergency dispatch systems of the City need to be compatible and effectively similar; and


WHEREAS: City code (Chapter 1300, subsection 1301.0 paragraph 9) provides that the normal purchasing requirements may be waived where it is deemed inadvisable to solicit bids because of a single source of supply or because of the need of standardization of materials, supplies and equipment or services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Keene in the interest of Public Safety authorize that the telephone systems of the fire and police departments be standardized around digital type equipment manufactured by the Panasonic Corporation. Such standardized equipment is available from several sources, the purchase and installation of same to be subject to the applicable purchasing procedures of the City.
