MONUMENTS

Upright monuments are permitted on cremation lots or when two or more adjacent full graves are owned. All monuments are subject to the approval of the Director's designee. All lots must be paid in full and accounts in good standing before a monument or marker is installed. The City is not responsible for the upkeep or repair of monuments.



SHRUB PERMITS

Lilacs, rose bushes, and dwarf variety shrubs are permitted with the purchase of a shrub permit. Plants shall not exceed the height of the monument. The City is not responsible for the upkeep of planted shrubs and bushes.

DEEDS

A deed will be issued once the purchaser has paid for the lot in full. Please allow several weeks for the deed to be processed and delivered via standard USPS. Please contact the main office regarding deed transfers.

BURIALS

Weekday burials shall be subject to overtime fees if services extend later than 3pm. Burials should be scheduled and confirmed with the main office at a minimum of 48 hours prior to service.

TIME OF INTERMENT

No burials shall take place at any other time of day than between sunrise and sunset unless permitted by the Director. Only in exceptional cases, will burials be allowed on recognized City holidays.

A concrete vault or cement liner is required for all full casket burials. No vault is required for urns made of wood, stone, hard plastic, or metal. Ceramic or pottery urns of any kind are prohibited without a vault.

FLOWERS AND POTTED PLANTS

Vases and potted plants may be placed on cemetery lots for Memorial Day but must be removed by September 30th of each year. Pots containing dead flowers/plants may be removed by the City at any time. Artificial flowers are prohibited from April 1st through October 31st.
