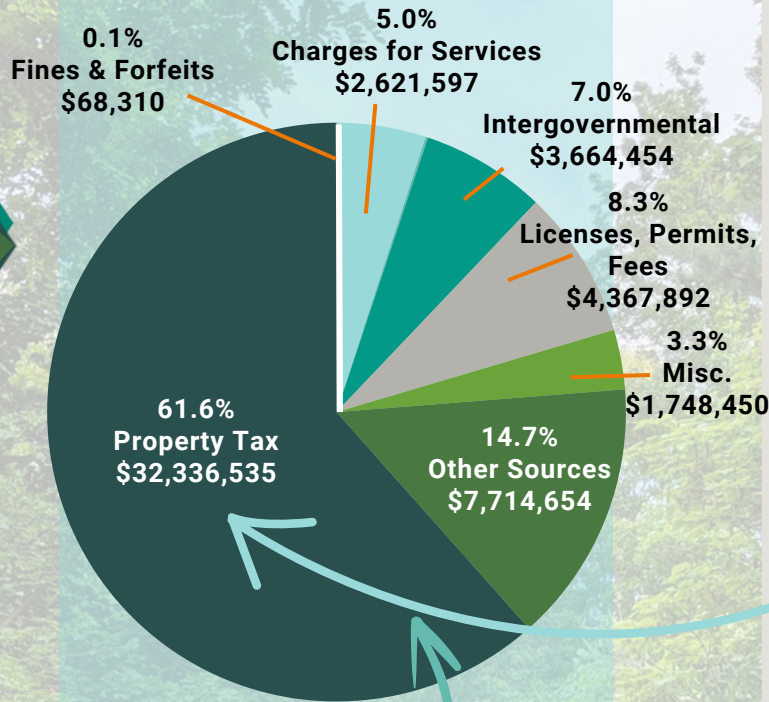

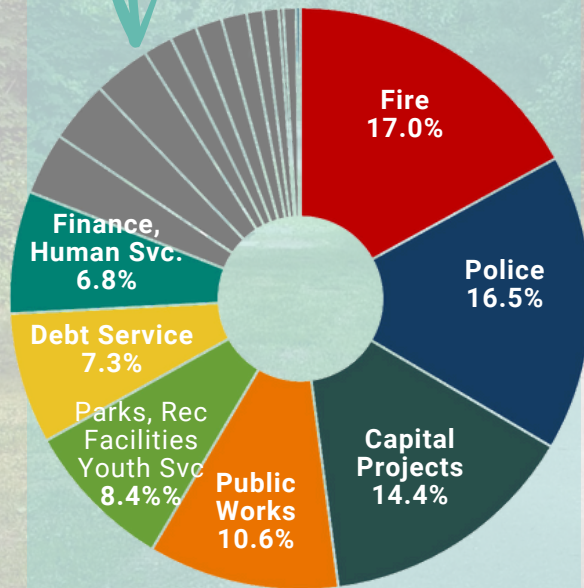

## Where Your Keene Property Tax Dollars Go

For a property valued at \$300,000, the property tax is distributed as follows:

\$5,334 **Schools**  
\$4,038 **City**  
\$921 **County**



The General Fund is the primary operating fund utilized by the City. It accounts for activities of the vast majority of City departments and functions. Other funds account for water, wastewater, recycling and disposal, parking, and equipment replacement functions.

\$32,336,535 of the City's Operating Budget for fiscal year 2025 (July 2024 through June 2025) will be raised through property taxes, and this amount will be used by the NH Department of Revenue Administration to set the property tax rate.
