

Book Sale Committee: Annual Report 2019-2020

Our year, 2019-2020, found us settling happily in to our new Friends space in the library. We held our first book sale, October 18-20, in the Library's newly renovated Heberton Hall. The sale was a success with proceeds of \$13, 229.85.

The process that was established for transporting donated books on a daily basis from the lobby donation bin continues to work well. There is a very dedicated team of volunteers who have each taken an assigned day of the week to move the bin and any accumulated boxes from the lobby to our work space. We are very thankful for their ongoing commitment to the Friends.

After the sale and during early winter a number of volunteers, on their own schedule, proceeded to sort, price and box our donations so that there was no need for a group sorting event.

Unfortunately the COVID-19 crisis led to the cancellation of this year's April book sale and the closure of the library. No donations are being accepted at this time.

A book sale is planned for this fall, October 16-19, but adjustments may be made as more information becomes available during these unusual times.

As always we want to offer our sincere thanks to all of our volunteers.
