CY 2022 Statistical Summary of Citizen Complaints/Internal Investigations

During calendar year 2022, six individual citizen complaints were lodged against the Keene Police Department or its individual members. These six complaints comprised three of nine categories we document. All citizen complaints were resolved at the supervisory or command staff level. There were no internal investigations during CY 2022.

There was not one type of allegation reported to the department that was higher than another. As shown above, 2 allegations were for Unprofessional Conduct, 2 allegations were for Ouality of Service and 2 allegations were reported for Use of Force.

This year shows a decrease of 40% in individual citizen complaints over CY 2021, where we had nine citizen complaints. Unfortunately CY 2022, is a 40% increase from CY 2020 where we had 4 individual complaints.

All complaints received were thoroughly reviewed and investigated and necessary remedial actions were taken as needed to discipline, educate and/or train officers where indicated. We strive to field professional, well trained Officers and employees and the actions taken are consistent with this effort. Each circumstance was unique and consequently no deficiencies in policy, protocol, or training were identified as a result of these reviews.
