	reet address must be clearly marked and visible (in contrasting color) from the street onting of the property
	e hydrants located on your property must be visible and accessible at all times, with ree feet of clearance on all sides and no parking within 10 feet.
qu	i t doors must open easily from the inside. Locking mechanisms on doors shall not re- ire special knowledge or keys. The only exception is a main storefront door with a sign ove that reads "This door must remain unlocked when building is occupied."
	sles, walkways, stairways and paths leading to exits must be clear of storage and ob- uctions.
fur	nergency lights and exit signs (that are lighted from within) must work properly and nction in both normal and emergency power mode. Lighted exit signs must be lit at all nes.
coi wh	ectrical extension cords cannot be used as a substitute for permanent wiring. Extension rds are only approved for "temporary use" (operating a vacuum cleaner, powering a tool nile making a repair etc.). Multi-outlet power strips with a built-in circuit breaker may be ed to protect computers and related equipment.
	e extinguishers must be visible, readily accessible, and serviced or purchased within the st 12 months.
	e sprinklers systems shall be serviced and tested annually by a licensed fire protection ntractor and inspected quarterly.
	e suppression systems for commercial cooking operations (Hood Systems) must be ser- ed and tested every six months by a licensed fire protection contractor.
	sidential Properties—Smoke alarms in every bedroom, smoke/co alarm on every level. rd wired with battery back up or wireless with 10 year batteries.
