A RESOLUTION Council Policy: Employee Computer Purchase Program

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Keene, as follows:

WHEREAS: The City of Keene desktop computing equipment including personal computers, laptop computers, printers, monitors and associated peripherals is maintained for a minimum of three to five years before replacement; and

WHEREAS: City of Keene taxpayers make an investment in the purchase and maintenance of City of Keene computing equipment required for City operations; and

WHEREAS: The sale of replaced City of Keene computer equipment may generate revenue which will reduce the total cost of supporting the organizational computing environment; and


WHEREAS: City of Keene employees who are valued and appreciated for their commitment to public service will benefit from an employee computer purchase program;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND KEENE CITY COUNCIL THAT:

The City of Keene employees are granted permission to purchase replaced City of Keene computer equipment at prices equal to current market value;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:
