

# A Message From the Director

A New Year's 2020 cartoon showed people being excited for the end of the year 2019 and the next year to begin. The common thought was that the COVID pandemic would end in the spring like a normal flu season and other societal problems would be resolved too. Instead, the pandemic continued with several spikes and world issues seemed to worsen. Change has been constant through the past year, at times daily and sometimes drastic. As of the writing of this report in August 2021, we are dealing with the more infectious and debilitating "Delta Variant" which is causing new concerns well after we had hoped that access to vaccines would finally end the pandemic. In reviewing the Library's hours for the City's benchmarking process, it was noted that the Library changed hours and services six times within the last fourteen months (May 26, 2020 - July 6, 2021). In the previous months of March 1-May 25, 2020, the hours and services changed an additional four times. For posterity, the hours and services through the pandemic to date is included with this report.

The Library staff would not have been able to accomplish the work that we have throughout the pandemic without the assistance of the other City departments. We have always relied upon the IT Department to keep our computers running and that became even more important as we introduced new technologies, moved back and forth through virtual-only, in-person and a combination of services and tried to keep the public informed. The Human Resources team was vital in keeping staff and their families healthy over the last year and a half. The Emergency Management Team, City Manager and Mayor were instrumental in gathering and disseminating information on local conditions. The Emergency Management Director made sure that we had pandemic related supplies so that the Library could keep the public and staff as safe as possible. The Facilities team did an amazing amount of work in extra cleaning, making changes to HVAC systems, installing safety barriers, as well as regular maintenance and taking on major COVID-related renovations in other departments.
