	COUNCIL POLICY: RELATING TO JOINT PROCUREMENT WITH
A RESOLUTION	OTHER STATE AND GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Keene, as follows:

WHEREAS: RSA 53-A authorizes governmental units of the State of New Hampshire to enter

into joint agreements related to governmental activities; and

WHEREAS: RSA 53-A: 3: I, requires appropriate action by resolution of the governing bodies

to authorize such agreements; and

WHEREAS: Section 2-1332 of the City Code relating to Purchasing permits purchases through

existing state, municipal and Keene School District contracts, but does not clearly

authorize entering into joint agreements; and

WHEREAS: The City and other governmental entities may explore mutually beneficial joint

procurement of common good and service or other agreements; and

WHEREAS: The City is charged with exploring opportunities to work collaboratively with

other governmental entities to reduce duplication of effort and to save money by combining purchasing and other resources in the marketplace in procurement of

goods and/ or services or other agreements; and

WHEREAS: The City and other governmental agencies intend to create joint public

solicitations and joint contracts for procurement of commonly used goods and/or

services; and

WHEREAS: The City intends to publicize results from joint efforts to enhance public

communication and information; and

WHEREAS: The City will continue to comply with all applicable Purchasing requirements as

required by City Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Keene, that City

staff be authorized to pursue joint procurement opportunities and create joint

contracts with other state and governmental entities in an effort to reduce

expenses in the procurement of goods and services; provided that City staff is aware

that the prices being paid by the City are competitive with the prices otherwise obtainable and are competitive in general; and provided that all applicable requirements of the City

Code are complied with.
