Moderators are required to submit this worksheet to their town or ward clerks within 48 hours of the closing of the polls (RSA 659:73). It is the moderator's job to ensure that votes are accurately counted (RSA 659:60)  For the State Primary Election, you must complete one form per party.

PART I.
The first part of the reconciliation process consists of <b>four separate tallies</b> : (A) <u>Ballots Cast</u> (Inventory), (B) <u>Voter</u> Participation Tallied at Check-In, (C) <u>Voter</u> Participation Tallied at Check-Out/ <u>Ballots</u> Cast Tape, and (D) Hand Count of <u>Ballots</u> Cast. Ideally, these <b>four counts should result in the same number</b> of <u>ballots</u> cast and <u>voters</u> participating (In the end, <b>TOTAL A = TOTAL B = TOTAL C = TOTAL D = TOTAL Count of</b> <u>Votes in Contests</u> (from Part II)). While we recognize that errors may occur which could result in small differences in the four Part I totals, Moderators are urged to <b>carefully consider</b> these tally numbers <b>before finalizing results</b> on election night.
