In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand and

Outdoor Lighting within the Public Right-of-Way and on Public Land

A RESOLUTION

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Keene, as follows:

WHEREAS, from time to time, Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH), d.b.a. Eversource Energy, may receive requests from third party individuals or entities to attach/install outdoor lighting on utility poles located within a public right-of-way or on public lands within the City;

WHEREAS, the City of Keene and PSNH, have entered into a March 2015 Memorandum of Understanding whereby PSNH will require the individual or entity making a request for outdoor lighting on utility poles located within a public right-of-way or on public land to provide a letter to the City Council stating the type of outdoor lighting and its location at least sixty (60) days prior to the installation date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF KEENE AS FOLLOWS:

Upon receipt of a written request the City Council will refer it to the Public Works Department.

The Public Works Department will notify, by first class mail, the owners of property, as identified in the City of Keene Assessing Database, located within one-thousand (1,000) feet in all directions of the outdoor light location in the agriculture, rural and corporate park zones and within four hundred (400) feet in all directions of all other zones.

Property owners will then have up to twenty-one (21) calendar days from the date of the notification to forward comments or concerns to the Keene City Council.

The City Council may, at its discretion, forward these concerns to the individual or entity making the request and PSNH.
