Mr. Schoefmann will schedule a meeting with the MRTC and the Southwest Regional Planning Commission to align on the implementation of the trail map.

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Safety initiatives were discussed, including community feedback channels. Discussion turned to the Tour De New Hampshire, and logistics and community coordination were reviewed for the upcoming event.

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Pavement for Bike Lanes in Downtown Project B)

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Mr. Schoefmann shared that they are still waiting on an update from Stantec's consultant report. Mr. Schoemann will present updated plans for the bike lane project at the next meeting. Outstanding questions that still need to be answered are what are Stantec's specific recommendations and the specific cost difference between the dyed green concrete and the standard concrete used for bike lanes.
