**Background:**

Monadnock View Cemetery is nearing capacity; while a short-term solution was sought from - and approved by - the Trustees to modify existing lots for additional cremation burial spaces, planning for cemetery expansion has been underway since 2023, when City Council supported the department's plan to move forward with contracting design services to create a Monadnock View Cemetery Expansion Master Plan.

After putting the project out to bid in late 2024, professional master planning and design services were contracted with Grever & Ward in early 2025 to evaluate long-term needs, site considerations, and phased expansion options. David Ward, of Grever & Ward, will be joining the committee meeting to present the master planning outcomes and proposed phasing, as well as answer any questions from the committee and/or the public.

Construction of the expansion is planned as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and will be supported through Trustee funding.
