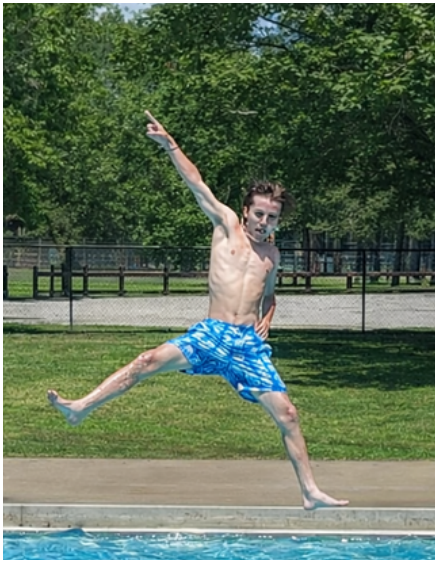

POOL PASSES & FEES

Pool Passes:

Individual: \$50 (\$65 Non-Resident)

Family: \$125 (\$150 Non-Resident)

Family Passes cover up to 8 people

Daily Fees:

\$2.00 per person

Children 3 and under are free

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Children ages 9 and under must be accompanied by someone at least 13 years old.
- Pool closures and updates will be posted on Keene Parks & Recreation Facebook and Instagram stories.
- Please respect KPRD lifeguards and follow all posted pool rules to help keep everyone safe.
- Glass containers are not allowed inside the fenced pool area.
- Proper swim attire is required; cotton materials are not permitted in the pool.
- Goggles that cover the nose are not allowed.
- All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- Only U.S. Coast Guard–approved lifejackets are permitted; other flotation devices are not allowed.
- A full list of pool rules is posted at each pool location.
- KPRD Summer Camps use the pools Monday–Friday from 1:00–3:00 PM. Pools remain open to the public during this time but may be busier than usual.

Set sail for a pirate-themed night at the pool!

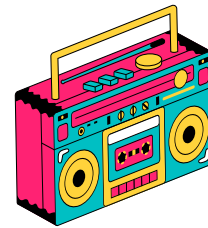
- Treasure hunt, walk the plank, noodle jousting, diving for coins

LEVEL

PREREQUISITES

Level One

- Can move comfortably through the water
- Can fully submerge face
- Can demonstrate kicking on front and back
- Can exit and enter water independently

Level Two

- Can float unsupported for 5 seconds
- Can retrieve objects underwater
- Can perform unsupported combined arm and leg movement on front and back
- Can enter and exit water independently

Level Three

- Can coordinate arms and legs for front and back crawl for 5 body lengths
- Can change directions while swimming
- Can float unsupported for 30 seconds

Level Four

- Can jump into deep water
- Can tread for one minute
- Can demonstrate rotary breathing during front crawl
- Can perform front and back crawl unsupported for 25 yards
